

Project: Bunny Bars

INSPIRED BY "SUN-DRENCHED STRIPS" BY DESIGNER PIECE O' CAKE DESIGNS



Fabrics are Bunny Luv Flannel, Woolies Light Flannel, and Tulips Flannel, all from Maywood Studio.

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This quilt in soft, pastel flannels is perfect for a baby quilt or for a toddler to cuddle up with on the couch. Or hang it on the wall for subtle Easter decoration.

Materials

- 13—9×22" pieces (fat eighths) assorted tone-on-tone flannels (rectangle rows)
- 1¾ yards cream floral flannel (sashing strips, border, binding)
- 2⅝ yards backing fabric
- 46×58" batting

Finished quilt: 39½×51½"

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From each assorted tone-on-tone flannel, cut:

- 6—2×5½" rectangles

From cream floral flannel, cut:

- 6—6½×39½" strips
- 5—2½×42" binding strips

Assemble Quilt Top

1. Referring to photo on page 1, lay out two each of the 13 tone-on-tone flannel 2×5½" rectangles; sew together along long edges to make a rectangle row. Press seams in one direction. The row should be 5½×39½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make three rectangle rows total.
2. Referring to photo, join rectangle rows and four cream floral flannel 6½×39½" strips. Press seams in one direction.

3. Add remaining cream floral flannel 6½×39½" strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top.

Finish Quilt

1. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
2. Bind with cream floral flannel binding strips.
